Dear Ms. Kremski:

The State Bar's information technology officer, William Kramer, advised me that the identity of the State Bar employee who sent anonymous and harassing e-mails to StateBarWatch has been ascertained and turned over to you. The purpose of this letter is to request that you reveal the identity of that individual and disclose any action taken by the State Bar to address this matter with that employee.

I must note, however, my concern over your involvement in this matter, as well as my pending character and fitness process. You will recall that I was present during your oral argument in the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals regarding the *Dean v. Byerley*, 354 F.3d 540 (6<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2004) case, and I witnessed your "misstatements" to the federal appeals panel. I then took action, when led to your October 8, 2003 filing with the panel that was styled "Correction of a Misstatement In The Record" (your document is available on the StateBarWatch website.)

In your defense, you told the federal appeals panel, "At the time of the submission of the brief and oral argument, counsel for Appellee-Byerley was unaware that Appellee-Byerley had a limited role in the admissions process." Yet, you failed to mention to the panel that you had worked under Mr. Byerley's auspices since at least May 4, 1999, as reflected in the State Bar's May press release ("As Assistant Counsel, Kremski will report to State Bar Regulation Counsel Thomas K. Byerley"). After I provided the Bar's May 4<sup>th</sup> press release to E. Stephen Dean, who then turned it over to the federal appeals panel, you then unexpectedly quit as Mr. Byerley's lawyer.

I ask that you disclose the information provided to you by Mr. Kramer and that you cease any further involvement in my dealings with the Michigan Bar.
